CELEBRANT: We are invited to the supper of the Lamb.

PEOPLE: Lord Jesus, you opened the eyes of the blind, healed the sick, forgave the sinful woman, and after Peter's denial, confirmed him in your love. Listen to my prayer, forgive all my sins, renew your love in my heart, help me to live in perfect unity with my fellow Christians, that I may proclaim your saving power to all the world.

(silence)

God, the giver of all mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins.

God gives you pardon and peace and absolves you from your sins.

Praise be to the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
